

## **PRIVACY POLICY**

### **of Quanta Cars website**

#### **I. General provisions**

1. This privacy policy sets out the principles of processing and protecting personal data provided by Users in connection with their use of car rental services through the Website.
2. The Service is a website located at [www.quanta.pl](http://www.quanta.pl), including its subpages and all applications located on the site.
3. The User is any person using the service in any scope.

#### **II. Data processing**

4. Processing of personal data takes place with respect for the required Polish legal regulations regarding security measures. Personal data is processed in accordance with the Act on the Protection of Personal Data of 01 May 2018 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act") for the purpose of providing services by the Service and the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (EU Official Journal L 119, p. 1) - hereinafter referred to as the GDPR. In the implementation of the above regulations, we hereby provide the following information:

- 1) **The Administrator of personal data** is Quanta Cars Sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Warsaw, al. Jana Pawła II 80/15, 00-175 Warsaw, entered into the register of entrepreneurs kept by the District Court for the capital city of Warsaw in Warsaw, XIV Economic Department of the National Court Register under the number KRS 0000473412, share capital of PLN 420,000, Tax Identification Number (NIP) 5532513487, REGON 243257050 (hereinafter referred to as "Quanta Cars" or "Administrator"), is the Administrator of personal data of Users.
- 2) **Purposes and legal basis of processing.** As the Administrator, we will process the User's data for the purpose of concluding and performing a lease agreement on the basis of the User's consent (under Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR). At any time, the User has the right to withdraw consent to the processing of personal data, but the withdrawal of consent does not affect the legality of processing carried out on the basis of consent prior to its withdrawal.
- 3) **Scope of processed data.** The Administrator of personal data processes the following personal data of the User :
  - a) name and surname,
  - b) address (street, house number, apartment number, city, postal code),
  - c) e-mail address,
  - d) telephone number,

- e) series and number of ID card or other identity document,
  - f) driving license number and categories covered,
  - g) PESEL number,
  - h) credit card number or bank account number,
- 4) **Right to object.** The User has the right to object at any time to the processing of their data described above. We will cease processing the User's data for these purposes unless we are able to demonstrate that we have compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the User, or the User's data are necessary for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims.
- 5) **Data retention period.** User's personal data resulting from the contract will be processed for the period during which claims related to this contract may arise, established in accordance with the provisions of civil, administrative, and tax law.
- 6) **Data recipients.** Our subcontractors (processing entities), such as accounting, legal, IT companies, damage liquidators, and service providers within the scope of damage liquidation, may have access to User's data.
- 7) **Rights of data subjects.** In accordance with GDPR, the User has the right to:
- a) access their data and obtain a copy of it;
  - b) rectify (correct) their data;
  - c) delete data, limit data processing;
  - d) object to data processing;
  - e) data portability;
  - f) lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.
- 8) **Information on the voluntary nature of providing data.** Providing data is voluntary but necessary for the conclusion and performance of the contract.
5. Completion, updating, rectification, or deletion of data can be made by using the contact form available on the website or by sending a registered letter to the address: QUANTA CARS Sp. z o.o., al. Jana Pawła II 80/15 00-175 Warszawa.
6. The Administrator does not trade data and does not transfer personal data of Users to other persons or institutions than those indicated above without the User's consent.
7. Processed personal data may, however, be made available without the User's consent to authorized public authorities at their request based on applicable laws or to third parties on the basis of decisions of competent authorities, in particular in the case of a universal mandate proceeding regarding the offense committed by the person who rented a vehicle from Quanta Cars.

8. Personal data transfer and authorization process, if used, is carried out using a secure SSL protocol. Informational, promotional, and offer messages are sent to the User's email address only after obtaining appropriate consent from them.

### **III. Cookies**

9. The website automatically collects information only through information contained in cookies.
10. Cookies are text files stored on the User's end device, intended to ensure optimal use of the website and enabling faster and easier access to information. Cookies are not used for processing personal data, and their content does not allow for user identification.
11. Disabling cookies may make some elements of the website unavailable. Failure by the User to change their browser settings to disable cookies is equivalent to consenting to their use.

### **IV. Final provisions**

12. The Administrator applies technical and organizational measures ensuring the protection of processed personal data appropriate to the threats and categories of data covered by protection, in particular securing data against their disclosure to unauthorized persons, taking by an unauthorized person, processing in violation of applicable law, and changing, losing, damaging, or destroying.
13. In the event of a change in the applicable privacy policy, appropriate modifications to the above principles will be made available on the website.
14. In matters not regulated by this Privacy Policy, relevant provisions of Polish law apply.
